#### 20/183 Agree Minutes from the last Planning meeting held 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022

### 20/184 Matters arising from this meeting

**\$106** – when money becomes available from Colchester City Council (CCC). Cllr Bottwood has checked on this and the Unilateral Undertaking funding for the Tennis benches and new lighting at the Community Centre has been collected by CCC.

**Container Park at Lodge Lane** - the PC have written to the LPA and nothing has come back from the planning officer on the most recent communication. A follow up email will be sent for an update of the situation.

**Surya Foods Tendring Planning Application 20/00594/**FUL - This application was approved at the Tendring Planning Meeting on 22/9/22. It was decided that benefits to the food and drink distribution sector and job retention marginally outweighed the environmental issues.

#### 20/186 Planning applications

#### **Decisions received from Colchester City Council (CCC)**

**222383 - Turnpike Close** – 2 self-build dwellings – Refused.

The site was outside the village envelope and CCC added other reasons prompted by our own submissions.

**222566 - Bumblebee Cottage – extend height of chimney – Approved conditional.** 

222309 - (Listed building application) - 1 Adelphi Cottage - replacement

doors and windows – Approved with minor conditions

220406 - Alefounders House, Park Lane – attic bedroom – Approved conditional.

#### **New Applications received from CCC**

**191830 – Vistry Homes School Road** (application received 20/12/22)

Non-material amendment. To allow foundation works to be completed for whole site without written confirmation from Environment Agency (EA) and

statutory provider that adequate waste water and sewage treatment capacity is available to serve development.

The Developer has requested permission for laying foundations for the complete site (46 homes), agreement has been given to date for half the site. The PC have engaged with the Local Planning Authority (LPA) about this and raised major concerns. The LPA states that it would defend the position that only half of the site could be occupied until it was demonstrated that WRC and Sewerage network capacity exists and building beyond slab (foundation) level for the additional 23 homes would not be acceptable at this time. Nothing has been formally agreed as yet by the LPA.

# **223086 - Lions Farm Langham Lane Boxted** (application received 23/11/22) Erection of Barn. Consultation expiry 14/1/23.

This seems to be located in Boxted. Not a lot of information available on the portal. No objections identified.

## 222963-Footpaths 26&29 School Road Langham (application received 23/11/22)

**Diversion of Public Footpaths** 

Notification of a Public Path Diversion Order

# 20/188 Planning Applications 220595 (Williamsons Developments.) & 221510 (Guy Williamson) updates

**225095** – contact had been made with the planning officer at the LPA and asked why there was no recent update on the planning portal. Apparently, no update will be made to the portal until the S106 agreement has been signed off. **221510** – the planning department are still waiting for the amended plans to come back from the Developer and when these are received, they will inform the PC and a re-consultation will take place

#### 20/189 S106 Developer Contributions

CCC has issued an invoice to Vistry for the full amount, which relates to contributions due on 46 homes and the S106 contract cannot be changed as

first occupancy has now occurred. The invoice has been sent as the contract states this is due on first occupancy.

The amount has now also indexed and is considerably more.

Karen Syrett has sent out an email wanting more transparency with Parish Councils regarding S106 procedures. A meeting will be arranged when she is back in the office on 23<sup>rd</sup> January.

Colchester Association Local Council will also be contacted as they have indicated issues with this process in the past. Cllr Bottwood will contact them both.

Cllr Freeman was asked by Cllr Bottwood if he would take over matters relating to the S106 developer contributions in the future on behalf of the parish council. Cllr Freeman was happy to consider this and a meeting will be arranged between Cllr Freeman and Cllr Bottwood to go through the detail. Action Cllr Bottwood

It was advised that a full quote for the play area would be submitted to the LPA Parks & Leisure Enabling Officer, indicating the sum that would be requested for the S106 contribution which amounts to £45k.

## 20/190 Anglian Water update

This has also been covered under item 20/186 in relation to the Vistry Homes planning application 191830.

Sir Bernard Jenkin's office will be contacted to see if they have received a response to Sir Bernard's communication to Peter Simpson the CEO of Anglian Water.

It was agreed that the notes of the last meeting between the PC, Anglian Water & Sir Bernard Jenkin would be sent to the Environment Agency (EA). This may help to develop the dialogue with the EA. Action Cllr Bottwood

The PC sent a response to the scoping document consultation on 5/12/22 and it was agreed that this will be placed on the website by Cllr Armstrong. The next stage, which is another public consultation, will start in the second quarter of 2023.
